

Greetings from the Course...

The month of September brought us a much needed break in the heat and we have enjoyed some wonderful fall weather thus far. Our zoysia started to turn early this year thanks to a cold snap that saw night time temps in the lower 40's. There were lots of questions going around about my watering practices and some concern that the fairways were dying, I assure you the fairways are healthy and were receiving plenty of water. We did everything necessary to get our warm season turf ready for winter we just started a couple of weeks ahead of schedule. The greens were needle-tined right after labor day to open them up and get some air down into the root zone. This is less disruptive than aerification with similar results, we also top dressed twice last month to help the greens roll truer and faster. Our rough has suffered through an incredibly hot dry summer and we are still facing a drought that has no real end in sight. We did seed bare areas on all greenbanks and surrounds. These areas are getting water through our irrigation and I appreciate everyone keeping their carts off these areas while we are trying to get them to grow in. I was also able to seed some bare landing areas, around the clubhouse on north side and some of the larger bare areas in the deep rough. These areas are not irrigated and will need rain to grow, however, the seed is in the ground and will be viable through the winter so if we have a snowy winter like last year we will have a lot of new turf in the spring. We are going to start servicing carts this winter and we will be working on chainsaws and mowers for anyone who is interested, just let me know. As always if you have any questions about the course just ask.
